- 1. In order to achieve the graduation threshold of the department, student must complete 34 credits, of which 16 credits from required courses, 18 credits from core optional courses.
- Master students must write a degree dissertation, submit the dissertation to the dissertation defense committee,
 pass the public oral dissertation defense, and conduct the final revision to fulfill the requirements for
 graduation. The dissertation is compulsory but 0 credits.
- Students must either (i) take and complete the course Study of Language I or Study of Language II opened by
 Department of International Business, or (ii) pass an English Assessment or the English Joint Examination of
 Kainan University to fulfil English ability requirement for graduation.
- 4. Students must obtain at least one professional certificate in business management for graduation.
- Students must publish at least one professional paper in a journal or a conference before graduation. While no limit is set on the author order, a published paper can only be used by a master student to fulfill the requirements for graduation.
- 6. Academic Ethics are required courses for 0 credits. In accordance with Regulations of KNU Academic Ethics Courses, students could applied for academic degree oral defense after passing the academic ethics courses.
- 7. These courses regulations were passed at the Curriculum Committee Meeting on May 21th. 2019, and approved for future references by Academics Affairs Meeting on May 21th, 2019.
- 8. These optional courses were passed and approved at the 1st Curriculum Committee Meeting of School of Business on September 17th. 2019.

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
